1. Each boat must consist of 2 anglers. 2. All teams must pre-register before launching. 3. Boat checks/Registration will begin at 5:00 a.m. Blast off will be at 6:00 a.m. or safe light. All boats must check-in at Check-In Boat by 3:00 p.m. 4. Un-sportsman like conduct will not be tolerated and will result in disqualification without refund. 5. Minimum boat length is 14 feet and working live well. 6. All Federal and Provincial boating regulations must be adhered to. 7. 5 Bass per team. No dead fish. Any dead fish will result in a 1-lb. penalty applied against the total weight of the team. 8. Event will be held rain or shine. 9. In the event of a tie, for any position the cash prizes for that position and the next position will be added together and distributed equally among the tied teams. 10. No locking permitted. 11. No alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs may be consumed or in possession of any competitor or boat during the Tournament hours. 5:30 a.m. to 5:30p.m. 12. No fishing allowed within 100 feet of another boat. 13. Decisions of the Tournament Officials are final. Protest will be allowed up to 15 minutes after the last team is weighed in. A \$50.00 deposit must be paid and will be refunded if protest stands. 14. Any team disqualified for any reason will not receive a refund of entry fees. 15. All taxes on any prize awards are the responsibility of the recipient. 16. If in the opinion of Tournament Officials any fish that is judged not likely to survive will be deemed a dead fish and a .50 lb. penalty will be applied. A dead fish is not eligible for big fish prize. 17. Personal floatation devices must be worn at all times the combustion engine is running and kill switch must be attached to boater. 18. It is the responsibility of the participants to bring fish up to the weigh-in from the boat. 19. All boats must check-in with the Check-In Boat by 3:00 p.m. A 5 lb. Penalty will be applied against any team that does not check-in with Check-In Boat. A late penalty of .5lbs. per minute will be applied to any team checking-in after 3:00 p.m. If an emergency situation arises, please notify Officials by phone. 20. I assume all risks associated with my participation in the Casting for Kids Tournament and understand that I am responsible for myself and my boat at all times. 21. If you have any questions on the rules be sure to clarify with the Organizers prior to Blast Off. 22. THIS IS A LIVE RELEASE TOURNAMENT.
